As a school we are particularly pleased with the progress rates of students based on their prior attainment levels, many of whom joined the school with low language skills. In addition, there are no gaps in the progress rates of disadvantaged students; this is a considerable achievement in a school with 64% students in receipt of pupil premium funding. We are equally proud of the number of higher grades secured by many of our students which is testament to the aptitude and attitude of our whole school community. Students and staff have worked tirelessly to ensure students have the best opportunities when they leave school. We know this set of results will provide an excellent platform for the students to go on to achieve amazing things, as well as inspiring future cohorts to believe in themselves.

Just some of our specific examples of success are.....

- Progress & attainment in Science was significantly higher than national with a progress score of +0.49. All our Science classes made excellent progress!
- Students in 11Sc1 achieved 65% grades 7-9 (A to A**) and 20% grades 6 (B) while 11Sc5 had fantastic progress rates with students making significantly better progress than their peers across the country.
- R.E produced some fantastic results with an overall progress score of +0.17. An amazing 71% of students achieved grade 9-4, 62% achieved 9-5 and 27 students achieving the top grade of 9-7 (A to A**).
- 83 top grades were awarded to our students overall!
- 37% of students achieved a top grade with 25% of our cohort achieving 2 or more higher grades.
